The Hornemann Institute of the University of Applied Sciences and Arts Hildesheim / Holzminden / Göttingen, is dedicated to international knowledge transfer for conservation specialists. Founded in 1998, the institute offers them on its constantly expanded access to:

- electronic publications in the field of cultural conservation, f.e. university papers, congress reports, essays and project documentations. The majority of the almost 900 abstracts of new degree dissertations are illustrated and are accessible both in German and in English. 30 of the theses are available for complete download. Contact addresses, provided by the authors, enable further information exchange.
- Internet-based continuing training modules which enable the users to pursue their personal training in an individual and flexible way.
- Service pages which acquaint the users with the most recent research possibilities of acquiring specialist literature via Internet and links to databases, online-publications and additional resources in this field.

The German Commission for UNESCO (DUK) values the activities of the Hornemann Institute to the point of its Executive Committee having granted an exceptional institutional patronage to the new centre. The center bears the name of the first German explorer of Africa, Friedrich Konrad Hornemann, who was born in Hildesheim in 1772.
