

## Landesarchiv Baden-Württemberg on-line

The Landesarchiv Baden-Württemberg secures, preserves and complements the authentic archives of the Land and makes them accessible to the public at large. The Landesarchiv has a departmental structure and consists of the Generallandesarchiv Karlsruhe, Hauptstaatsarchiv Stuttgart, Staatsarchive Freiburg, Ludwigsburg, Sigmaringen, Wertheim and Hohenlohe-Zentralarchiv Neuenstein and three special departments.

The Landesarchiv Baden-Württemberg is an active service provider. Its holdings are on-line completely. A larger part is already described in more detail in on-line finding aids which describe single archives in one file. Using the web one can request selected files and archives from home in advance before coming to the reading room in one of the archives.

The Landesarchiv Baden-Württemberg invites you to research and browse its holdings. It also offers e-learning facilities by presenting digitised holdings on-line. Moreover it edits selected archives in educational materials and prepares presentations for teaching and learning. Virtual guided tours enrich the on-line presentation.

The Landesarchiv showed a presentation of selected digitised holdings, amongst them the emigration database ([www.auswanderer-bw.de](http://www.auswanderer-bw.de)), the database of monasteries in Baden-Württemberg ([www.kloester-bw.de](http://www.kloester-bw.de)), the digitised photographic collection of Willy Prager ([www.landesarchiv-bw.de/prager\\_auswahl](http://www.landesarchiv-bw.de/prager_auswahl)) and the collection of award-winning artistic postcards from the beginning of the 20th century gathered in the Velten collection in Karlsruhe ([www.landesarchiv-bw.de/velten](http://www.landesarchiv-bw.de/velten)).
